Backpack - **NOT** on wheels!

1 pack of 12 MY FIRST Ticonderoga Primary Pencils (please sharpen)

3 dry erase markers (replenish when needed)

6 LARGE glue sticks - **Elmer's brand only** (replenish when needed; **NO** small glue sticks)

Please do not label the pencils, dry erase markers, or glue.

1 box of tissues (replenish when needed)

2 marble notebooks

4 bottom pocket folders

3 packs of 24 CRAYOLA crayons

1 pack of 24 CRAYOLA **mini-thick** Twistables

1 set of watercolor paint with paint brush

- 7 folders (with pockets at the bottom). If you purchase the plastic folders, they last a lot longer than the cardboard folders. Please label one folder for each of the following subjects:
 - Reading
 - Writing
 - In-School
 - Homework
 - Friday Folder (Ms. Levine's class ONLY)
 - Music
 - Social Studies

- 6 sharpened pencils – NO MECHANICAL PENCILS
